QUILTING DIVISIONS

All entries in these divisions must be the sole work of the exhibitor unless otherwise noted, and must be produced within one year of the opening date of the fair. Each entrant is responsible for selecting the proper category. All entries will be judged in their entirety as a finished quilt. **All quilts must have 4" hanging sleeve on the back. Due to limited space, some quilts may not be shown in their entirety. Every effort will be made to show ribboned quilts to their best advantage.**

Amateur: One who does not pursue the craft as a professional and does not receive monetary or other benefits from their craft.

Professional: A person who engages in an activity or event as a livelihood or for profit. May not enter like items in amateur class.

Novice: Individual who has never received a first place or blue ribbon in any fair or show.

Limit one entry per exhibitor per class

(Quilt pieced by amateur and machine quilted by a professional)

3. Quilt - pieced
4. Quilt - tied
5. Quilt – pre-printed

7. Baby or Small Quilt – not to exceed 180" in perimeter
8. Small Wall Hanging – not to exceed 120" in perimeter
9. Other not listed i.e. wholecloth

DIVISION 249 - MISCELLANEOUS QUILTS

CLASS:

1. Friendship Quilt – assembled and quilted by exhibitor
