CLASS:

1. Ouch! – Use barbed wire and dried flowers
2. Candy Apple – Miniature, 5 inches or less, with red flowers
3. Horns and Hides – Exhibitor's choice
4. Buttons and Bows – Use buttons and/or bows
5. Buckles and Boots – Use buckles and/or boots
6. Box Lunch – Make an old fashioned box for a box social, or use a lunch box

DIVISION 312 - EXHIBITORS – AGES 14 – 17

CLASS:

1. One Sole at a Time – Use shoe or boot
2. Two Step – Use containers of two heights
3. Barn in the USA – Use barn wood, or shape of barn
4. Fiddlin' Around – Use fiddle and/or bow
5. Country Thyme – Use thyme and other herbs
6. Dancing with the Steers – Exhibitor's choice
