Entries limited to students enrolled in the Fall River and Big Valley School Districts.

After weighing, market lambs may be divided into weight lots within the specified limitations as desired for convenience in Judging. Due to weight variances, entries should be made by Division Number and Class Number only. Animals will be classified by class in accordance with instructions in Local Rules. Feeder Lambs do not sell in the Jr. Livestock Sale, but they are eligible for showmanship.

The purpose of the Ladies Lead Class is to promote the use of Wool and to give spectators an opportunity to view Sheep and a product they produce in an attractive manner. Entries in this class will be open to any young lady ages 9 through 18 years. Sheep may be breeding ewes or market lambs and may be brought onto the Fairgrounds for the sole purpose of this Show, but still have to be inspected on Wednesday Aug. 31, 2011 with all other sheep. No Ram Lamb animals will be permitted. Sheep must be conditioned, fitted and trained to show at halter. Exhibitor need not be the owner. The entrant will be judged on the mode of dress selected. Clothing may range from a scarf to a three-piece outfit, with material being at least 70 percent wool. Article need not be handmade.

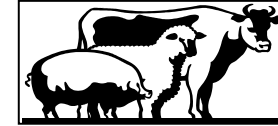
