- All entries in these divisions must be home prepared and canned or packaged by the exhibitor within one year of the date of the Fair. Items which have been shown at any previous fairs are not eligible. All products being considered for the cash awards which have not otherwise been eliminated from the consideration will be opened.
- Standard jar: a container specifically or especially designed for canning purposes. No paraffin seals. All canning must be in sealed jars.
- Please loosen rings, but leave the lids on entries when bringing to the fair. Exhibits must be in glass container, $40 z$ and up. Spicy entries must have warning label.
- Non-acid foods: all vegetables, meats, poultry and fish must be canned under pressure. Low-acid fruits, such as figs, should be made more acidic by adding lemon juice, as directed in the USDA Canning Rules. "Tomatoes and fruits (not including their juices) must be processed in a boiling water batch.
